#### Local musicians will attend/attend Music Teachers state conference

Ms. Melody Maker of Busyville, South Dakota and three of her piano students will attend/attended the 58th state conference of the South Dakota Music Teachers Association, to be held/held at Black Hills State University in Spearfish, November 1-3. Concerts, workshops and student competitions are/were the featured activities of the annual fall event. Guest artist for the conference will be/was South Dakota native, pianist Eugene Gienger. Additional state and regional performers, clinicians and adjudicators will be/were featured.

The South Dakota Music Teachers Association (SDMTA) was founded in 1955 to serve the needs of studio teachers teaching music to individuals or small groups of students. The organization is an affiliate of Music Teachers National Association (MTNA), a group which now has a membership of 24,000 music professionals in fifty states and the District of Columbia. SDMTA is further supported through five local associations in Aberdeen, the Black Hills, Brookings, Huron and Sioux Falls.

Three of Ms. Maker's students will participate/participated in the Elementary and Junior piano competitions on Saturday, November 5. Performers are/were Furious Fingers, age 11, daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Parent Fingers, Powerful Chords, age 13, son of Ms. Solid Chords, and Gentle Soul, age 12, daughter of Ms. Good Woman and Mr. Helpful Soul. Each student will perform/performed two memorized pieces and will receive/received written comments from the competition adjudicators. Gentle Soul was awarded First Place in the Age 12 category. Furious Fingers performed with other Busyville pianists on Saturday evening in the multi-piano Extravaganza.

Ms. Maker has owned and taught at Top Notch Music Studios since 1992 and is a member of the Local Area Music Teachers Association. She has a bachelor's degree in music from Best University and serves as pianist for the Busyville Community Choir. Ms. Maker completed her music teachers certification through MTNA and her state certification through SDMTA in 1994. She teaches solo and group piano lessons with additional classes in music theory, music history and music performance. Ms. Maker's students perform in the annual City Christmas concert, Top Notch Studio annual recitals and in SDMTA and Piano Teachers Guild festivals and competitions. The Top Notch Music Studios' Fall recital will be held on Sunday, December 4th at 3:00 p.m. in the Beautiful Church at 17 Autumn Lane in Busyville. The public is invited to attend. ## Registration Policies for Members

Because SDMTA has a small membership, it is important that each member do their part to make the state conference run smoothly. During the conference we need not only a site host and chair people to run the competitions, but members to be monitors, sit at the registration table, work at the IMTF luncheon, provide snacks for the hospitality room, etc. The \$35 conference fee is extremely minimal when you look at the cost of attending other conferences. That conference fee and student registrations help make it possible for us to hold our state conference each year. Members attending the state conference should register whether they are coming to hear only one of their students compete or coming for the whole 3 day conference. In addition, each member attending should be willing to help in some way at the conference, such as monitoring a competition or sitting at

the registration desk. On the conference registration form you will be able to check in which way you would be willing to help. The **Executive Board feels** this is extremely important to the success of our conference and for our state to be able to continue to hold these conferences. Without our state members helping both physically and financially, we may no longer be able to hold these conferences.

Please notice that we have two new competition chairs for this year: Joseph L'Amour as composition chair and Russell Svenningsen as SDMTA vocal chair. Application forms and the handbook are now on the SDMTA website. Please observe the deadlines—3:00 Eastern time on Sept. 12 for MTNA competitions and Sept. 21 for SDMTA competitions. Also note that we are going back to the old way of sending both the check and

application via regular mail to the chairs. There were too many issues with checks arriving after deadlines. Applications still must be typed. When sending your applications, please allow enough time for them to arrive to the chairs by the deadline. Also note that national has changed the membership deadline slightly—members must have joined before entering students. The same applies to our SDMTA competitions. Again, please send those membership fees in early, allowing for them to arrive at national and for them to be posted on time.

Thank you for your cooperation in these matters which will help things to run much more smoothly for our competitions.
